

# Introduction to R for Epidemiologists

## Homework Instructions

In order to receive full credit for your homework assignments, you must do the following:

- Name your file “LASTNAME\_560R\_hw0.R” for homework assignment 0
- To grade your assignment, we need to be able to run your code. To ensure that we will be able to run your code, do the following in RStudio:
  1. Type `rm(list = ls())` in your console to remove all R objects
  2. In the console, set your working directory to the directory where your homework data are stored
  3. Open your homework .R file
  4. Click source in the upper right hand corner in the editor. You should not receive any errors or messages.
  5. Type `ls()` in the console to ensure you’ve created all the objects for the homework
  6. Your plots should also render in the RStudio Plots tab
  7. **Remove any references to your own computer. This includes any file paths, `getwd()`, `setwd()` commands.**
- Use proper spacing, indentation, naming, and commenting as discussed in lecture 1 and as described in the referenced style guides. This is 16.7% of your homework grade!
